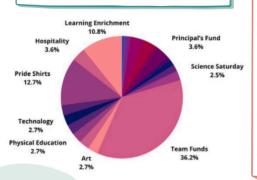


THE PTO BUDGET BREAKDOWN

A NOTE FROM THE TREASURER

"The goal of PWM PTO is to support the schools needs. We primarily do that that through fundraising to fill the gaps that the districts funding may not cover. Our main income generator is the fall walk-a-thon but we also have smaller events or contributions that allow up to support teachers, specials and events at the school. Majority of the walk-a-thon funds a divide up to the different teams of classrooms in the school. They are divided up on a per pupil basis and are at the discretion of the Team Teacher how to use the fund. It may be additional materials for the team or to bring in a special program or presenter. Specials teachers also get additional fund to use for their curriculum enrichment. There are additional expense throughout the year that we have voted on distributing money towards. The budget is review and voted on every year."
